- Plan and implement staff development activities at the building level, based on needs and the site improvement plan.
- Model the essential differentiated instruction in the classroom.
- Maintain and improve professional competence through continued training in the areas deemed appropriate by the principal.
- Support and implement professional, cooperative relationships with teachers, administrators, and staff development team members.
- Disseminate information and materials on effective instruction to teachers and administrators.
- Provide on-site support and monitoring for a successful school-wide implementation and evaluation of site math instructional initiatives.
